Who is it for?

Middle or senior leaders who have responsibility for teaching and learning within a subject, across a phase or throughout the school.

SLEs who provide school to school support in primary.

Aspiring senior leaders in any aspect of primary school leadership.

Content & Delivery

Teaching and learning: observing lessons and giving feedback, learning walks, planning for the classroom, schemes of learning, marking and feedback, challenge and independent learning. Excellent teaching.

Leadership: information seeking, planning at whole school level, influencing people, managing change, accountability and quality assurance.

The sessions will take place in primary school settings and delegates will benefit from sharing best practice from across a range of schools. The course will include the opportunity to conduct learning walks and consider different approaches to teaching and learning in different settings.

This programme is designed to give teachers the skills to improve teaching and learning within their own school. With opportunities to reflect on current practice across a range of schools, delegates will have the opportunity to work with colleagues with similar responsibilities and implement a teaching and learning improvement project in school
