The basic requirements on uniform are:

Hooded tops and sweatshirts must not be worn for school in place of a coat.

We do not allow number one hair cuts, extreme hair cuts, extreme hair colours or coloured hair wraps/extensions. Pupils should not have their hair cut below a '2' and the length should be blended.

No jewellery apart from a wrist watch is allowed for either boys or girls. Plasters over earrings are not acceptable. Pupils wishing to have their ears pierced should do so at the beginning of the summer holiday period to allow piercings to heal.

Nail varnish/false nails/Gelation incl. Shellac are not acceptable. No make-up/false tan. Facial hair is also unacceptable.

We expect all pupils to wear the uniform properly; for example we do not allow pupils to wear their shirts/blouses outside their trousers/skirts. Shirts and blouses must have a proper collar which has been designed to be worn with a tie and the top button must be fastened.

Breaches of school uniform will result in sanctions. Pupils arriving in school not dressed correctly will be sent home to change.

With regard to uniform and appearance matters, Ripley staff will make the decision about acceptability.
