Proposed Visit to The Lowry Theatre, Manchester

We are proposing to run a trip to The Lowry Theatre to watch a performance of An Inspector Calls on Wednesday 15 January 2020 for the current Year 9, 10 and 11.

We will depart from school on Wednesday 15 January 2020 at 17:30 and travel to Manchester by coach. We will arrive back at school at approximately 23:00.

The cost of the trip will be £30 per pupil which includes travel and a ticket to the performance.

The trip is open to all students who are currently in Year 9, 10 and 11 and we anticipate that it will be popular. There are only 85 places available and they will be offered on a **first come, first served basis**. **If you wish your son/daughter to take part in this visit, please complete the attached application form and make payment by Thursday 10 October 2019**. The form should be returned to the blue box outside Learning Support in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name and "An Inspector Calls 2020" on the outside.
